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Board Policy 3.2.1

Curriculum Development

The Board is dedicated to providing a rigorous academic program accompanied by high-quality arts education, and recognizes its responsibility for the improvement and growth of the educational program of the school. To this end, the curriculum shall be evaluated, adapted and developed on a continuing basis.

For purposes of this policy, curriculum shall be defined as all planned learning activities of the schools.

The Board is responsible for the curriculum of the schools. The Board directs that the curriculum of this school be consistent with the AACS charter, written goals, objectives and identified pupil needs.

As educational leader of the district, the Principal shall be responsible to the Executive Director and the Board for the development of curriculum, and shall establish procedures for curriculum development.

With the exception of world language and specialized programs for students with Limited English Proficiency (LEP) and English Language Learners (ELL), all courses shall be taught in the English language.
